INVITATION TO A PHYSICAL AND VIRTUAL EARLY MARKET ENGAGEMENT CONFERENCE

The Government of South Sudan (GoSS) has received funding from the World Bank toward the cost of implementing Access and Institutional Strengthening Project (ASSIST) and is being implemented by the Ministry of Energy and Dams (MoED) and South Sudan Electricity Corporation (SSEC)

The Project seeks to increase access to electricity services and strengthen the institutional capacity of the electricity sector in Juba, Yei, and Upper Nile Region and Bahra-Gazal, in South Sudan. The Project has four components. The first three components are investment components that aim to increase access to electricity services through isolated grids and off-grid interventions. The fourth component is intended to strengthen the sector's institutional capacity as well as the overall project implementation capacity, which is foundational to achieving the Project Development Objectives.

The MoED has prepared the draft Procurement Documents for the following procurement packages;

Package 3 – (C3)	Lot 1: Planning, Design, Supply, installation and Commissioning Off-Grid Solarization for Public Health and Education Institutions in Jonglei State, Greater Equatoria, and Greater Bhar El Ghazal Lot 2: Planning, Design, Supply, installation and Commissioning Off-Grid Solarization for Public Health and Education Institutions in Unity State and Ruweng Administrative Area Lot 3: Planning, Design, Supply, installation and Commissioning Off-Grid Solarization for Public Health and Education Institutions in Upper Nile State
